Residential EV Incentive Program (REV): Terms and Conditions

- 1.Vernon Public Utilities (VPU) residential electric customers are eligible for up to \$2,500 in rebates, when a new or used plug-in electric vehicle (EV) is purchased or leased.
- 2.VPU customers are allowed to receive rebates for up to 2 EVs, per residential electric service address.
- 3. Purchased or leased EVs are eligible for incentives.
- 4.New or used EVs are eligible for incentives.
- 5. Applicant must have an active residential electric account in good standing with VPU.
- 6.EVs are required to be registered at the address of the VPU residential electric customer applying for the rebate.
- 7.Submit your REV incentive application within <u>180 days</u> from date of purchase.
- 8.Plug-in Electric Vehicle (EV) must be registered with the Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) in California
- 9.A maximum of two (2) incentives can be applied per VIN, but each incentive must be tied to a unique VPU residential electric service address and account holder, with a 36-month period in between each incentive.
- 10. The program participant must be the legal owner of the EV and permanently reside at the address shown in the VPU residential electric account.
- 11.EVs must be approved for highway application. (Electric scooters, electric bicycles, golf carts, neighborhood and low-speed vehicles are not eligible.)
- 12.EVs transferred from a family member, gifted, or won as a prize will not qualify for the rebate. Under no circumstances shall the rebate amount exceed the cost of the EV.
