Vernon Public Utilities Earns Fourth Straight Reliable Public Power Provider (RP3) Award

Vernon, CA – Vernon Public Utilities (VPU) is pleased to announce that once again, it has been awarded the Diamond Level, Reliable Public Power Provider (RP3) award from the American Public Power Association (APPA).

The Diamond Level award is the highest possible designation and represents the top 5% of public power utilities across the United States. This achievement recognizes public power utilities that abide by industry-recognized leading practices while demonstrating high proficiency in four important disciplines: reliability, safety, workforce development and system improvement.

The 2025 RP3 designation, which is in effect for three years, marks VPU's fourth straight diamond level award and second consecutive perfect score. This award recognizes VPU's continued commitment to operating an efficient, safe and reliable electric distribution system.

VPU also demonstrated its continued commitment to workplace safety by receiving the APPA Safety Award of Excellence in 2024. As part of the selection process, VPU distinguished itself amongst over 200 participating utilities. This award is based on low incident rates and robust safety programs, which reflect VPU's strong safety culture and adherence to OSHA standards.

In addition to RP3 and safety, VPU has also been nationally recognized for Excellence in Reliability in 2024 through APPA's eReliability Tracker program. VPU's performance was compared nation-wide, using data from the U.S. Energy Information Administration, which placed VPU among the top 25th percentile in the country.

VPU's dedication to maintaining a safe working environment, commitment to staff development, improving its system year over year, providing reliable utility services,

minimizing power outages, and ensuring business continuity are key factors that contributed to the prestigious awards that are recognized by the public power industry.
