PRE-ELECTION DAY PROCESSING AND ELECTION DAY CANVASSING

(For Vote by Mail ballots received prior to or on Election Day)

Pursuant to Elections Code Section 15101(a), processing of Vote by Mail ballot return envelopes (verification of signature and address and updating voter records) may begin 29 days before the election, and will commence Monday, March 16, 2026, at 7:00 a.m., City Hall City Clerk Department. Vote-by-Mail ballot return envelope processing may occur daily thereafter between 7:00 a.m. and 5:30 p.m. To determine if ballot processing will take place on a particular day, call (323) 583-8811, ext. 546.

The Canvass and Count of the Vote by Mail ballots (those received on or prior to Election Day, which have been processed) will commence Tuesday, April 14, 2026, at 8:01 p.m., at City Hall Council Chamber.

POST-ELECTION DAY PROCESSING AND CANVASSING

(For Vote by Mail ballots received on Election Day and Vote by Mail ballots received up to seven days following the election, with postmarks on or before Election Day)

The post-election day processing of Vote by Mail ballot return envelopes will commence on Wednesday, April 15, 2026, at 7:00 a.m., City Hall, City Clerk Department. Vote-by-Mail ballot return envelope processing may occur daily thereafter between 7:00 a.m. and 5:30 p.m. To determine if ballot return envelope processing will take place on a particular day, please call (323) 583-8811, ext. 546.

The post-election day Canvass and count of the 2nd batch of Vote by Mail ballots will commence on Wednesday, April 22, 2026, at 2:00 p.m., at City Hall Council Chamber. If necessary, a second post-election day Canvass and count for the 3rd batch of vote-by-mail ballots will be announced and posted.
